As the Foreign Office knows I have been disheartened about the situation in Borneo & Celebes for months. The slaughter and brutality is now so terrible, and of a nature which the East was once fought to prevent, that I have prepared and sent the enclosed letter to Douglas on the facts, and course of action which can be taken.

As far as I personally am concerned

I am trying to help relieve the
suffering a little by assisting Lady Noel
in her efforts to have a British
camp to look after some of the refugees.
But that is not a solution. These
people want to live peacefully in
their own land.
